Safeguarding means keeping people safe.



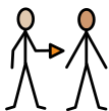
Abuse?



Abuse is when someone hurts you or does something



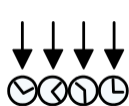
with you that upsets or frightens you.




 You  must  tell  someone if  you are  told or  hear
